
Mission

A systems approach

We must go beyond the conventional crisis response plan and establish enterprise-wide strategies aimed at reducing our overall risk to crisis and disasters.



Stages of Persuasive Communication



Awareness is defined as:

Understanding is defined as:

- c: to have thorough or technical acquaintance with or expertness in the practice of
- d: to be thoroughly familiar with the character and propensities of
- 2 : to accept as a fact or truth or regard as plausible without utter certainty





Acceptance is defined as:

- an agreeing either expressly or by conduct to the act or offer of another so that a contract is concluded and the parties become legally bound
- 2: the quality or state of being accepted or acceptable
- 3 : the act of accepting : the fact of being accepted : APPROVAL

UOEM Program Objectives Cont.


- Strive for multi-dimensional communications (e.g. redundancy to ensure multiple modes of communications) to enhance education, awareness, and understanding.
